Solstice Advanced Materials was created through the spin-off of the former Advanced Materials business of Honeywell International Inc., announced on October 8, 2024, and completed on October 30, 2025. As an independent, publicly traded company, Solstice holds leading market positions in semiconductor materials, industrial-grade fibers, refrigerants, and healthcare packaging solutions. Our global manufacturing footprint includes 21 manufacturing sites and three R&D sites.

This letter is to provide updates on products for the Electronic & Specialty Materials (“ESM”) team. This includes our electronic materials, industrial-grade fibers, laboratory life sciences materials, and specialty chemicals, distributed and sold through the Spectra[®], Fluka[™], and Hydranal[™] brands. This segment includes our Research Chemical and Specialty Additives business.

You will continue to be served with the same trusted brands and products, such as:

Product labeling will transition over time and is largely dependent on stock levels and ship-to-country legislation. Starting December 26, 2025, customers will begin to see updates to the SDS, ASIS and GHS Labels. Other labeling changes will follow, and we will provide details when these are planned to occur. In the interim, please be assured:

- Solstice packaging is the same as prior Honeywell packaging with adjustments only to company identification where needed.
- You will continue receiving the same trusted materials with no changes to product content or quality.

We want to emphasize that our facilities, Manufacturing, Measurement and Quality Assurance processes have not changed and there is no impact on Form, Fit, Function or Appearance of our products.

Our work to complete a final update to our Certificates of Analysis/Compliance with our new logo continues. Once completed, the logo on the CoA/C will indicate "Solstice". Legal entity names of several of our sites and businesses will include "Honeywell" through a transitional period into that could last until 2027.

Changes to physical product engraving for our Sputtering Targets and Coils will be deployed in 2026. We will share clarity on future engraving and timing once defined.

Last, ESM is working with our Quality Registrars to update names from Honeywell to Solstice. As with other changes, these will phase in over time as upcoming audits occur and new certificates are generated. Our existing certificates are valid until the Registrars update the documents.

We will continue to share additional information as we receive further updates during this transition period.
